## Mountain Bike Event

### Four Hours For Hope!



July 17<sup>th</sup>, 2010 - River Falls, WI

The Rhino Rally is a four hour mountain bike event, raising cancer awareness and financial support for the Rhino Foundation. The Rhino Foundation has been helping families impacted by cancer for over fifteen years.

The Rhino Rally will be held on the Whitetail Ridge Mountain Bike trail just North of River Falls, WI. The White Tail Ridge course is a five mile loop consisting of a combination of single and double track.

Riders can register for the event as individual participants or as a team of two. If participating as a team, only one rider from each team will be on the course at any given time.

#### Registration fee

\$30 prior to July 1<sup>st</sup>.  
\$35 after July 1<sup>st</sup> or on event day.

#### Additional Challenge

In addition to the registration fee, participants are encouraged to raise additional funds to contribute to the Rhino Foundation. Participants are not required to raise additional funds beyond the registration fee, but a target goal of \$100 per rider has been set. What would your family, friends, and/or co-workers contribute to your four hour off road challenge?

Prizes will be awarded to the participants who raise the most sponsorship dollars.

Participants completing the most laps during the event will also be eligible for prize drawings.

All participants will receive a Rhino Rally t-shirt. In addition, riders will be supported during the event with nutrition and hydration.

Festivities during and after the ride will make the event enjoyable for spectators as well as participants.
